
Country Report

To access and download the Country Report from Healix, visit <https://tow.healix.com/login>. If this is your first time using the resource, you will need to register first by clicking on “Register” and completing your details, including using the University of Leeds’ travel insurance policy number, **ZUR1531523**.

Once registered/logged in, click on “Countries” on the left menu, then select the relevant region and country your proposed partner University is situated in.

SECURITY RISK **LOW**

Crime

There is a LOW risk of crime throughout Canada, with the primary threat facing foreign nationals emanating from petty and opportunistic criminals. Acts of pickpocketing and bag snatching are frequently reported. The most affected areas frequented by foreign nationals include main transport hubs, tourist attractions and centre squares in major urban centres. Other criminal threats include property theft, verbal and sexual harassment, and assault. Criminals often act alone, but can sometimes operate in pairs or groups, using distraction techniques against the target while another carries out the crime. Recent years have seen an increase in hate crimes in Canada and individuals belonging to visible minority groups, particularly those of East Asian and Southeast Asian descent, are more likely to face race-based harassment.

There has been an increase in violent crime in recent years, with monthly counts of police-reported violent crime either at or above pre-pandemic levels. Types of violent crime reported include sexual
